Double Messages: One of my professors told of scientific research on ants and communication. They communicate by smell. The enzyme that indicates death was put on a worker ant. His problem was he was sending out more than one message; one said he was alive and well and another he was dead. We can do the same unintentionally. Recently it was pointed out to me that sometimes I send a double message: my mouth says "I care about you" but my actions say "I don't care about you". It is called body language. After searching my heart, I've decided my body is lying! Evidently the offence is especially evident while in the foyer and speaking to folks leaving. I am guilty of often looking away and elsewhere while shaking hands. If you are offended by this, please forgive me and try to understand my intent. I am looking to make contact with those whom I want to especially encourage or who are visiting with us. It is not that I don't care about you; I do care. Paul says some "parts" of the body need more attention than other parts and if I send an unintended message while trying to find those who need special attention, please simply forbear. Thank you.

Elaine graduated from the high school and attended David Lipscomb for 2 years then transferred to Peabody College. She started working for WSIX-TV and also was a fashion model for the department stores in Nashville. Later she moved to Manhattan, NY. There she worked for Paramount Pictures in the music department. After 2 years she returned to Nashville and worked on Music Row for Purcell Associates, who managed talents such as Eddy Arnold, Al Hirt & many others. Later she worked for RCA's publishing company and the recording company, which were all very interesting.

Elaine married Spider Rich who she met through Chet Atkins. Spider was a instrumental writer and lead guitar player. He wrote "Yakety Sax" for Boots Randolph. Chet Atkins recorded 16 of Spider's songs.

Following Spider's retirement, they returned to Winchester to care for Elaine's mother.

Elaine has one daughter Susan who lives in Huntsville, AL.

After Spider passed away she states, "the church was so good to me. I will always be grateful to everyone. Betty Fraley & Cowan Simmons always checked on me, and Ruth Julian is a very dear and true friend. I cherish all my good memories and friends that I have loved for many years. This is a wonderful church."
