Spiritual Growth Takes Time: It is "line upon line, here a little, there a little". Paul told the young minister Timothy, "give attention to reading, to exhortation, to teaching... give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all." I continue to study, read, think, pray and grow. I challenge every one of us to do the same. We likely will not see the growth. It comes incrementally, gradually; but it does come! Patience! Steadfastness! Here a little, there a little! At every opportunity encourage growth you see in others; commend it, praise it. And they will work all the harder to grow more.
