Below is a summary report on the Russia missions work sponsored by the Winchester congregation.

#### Russian Missions Work:

The Winchester congregation sponsors the Kirov church, which was established when Ed Bogges and several others evangelized this large city in north-central Russia. After meeting in a rented location for several years, the congregation was able to move into a modern building with the financial support coming from Winchester.

Although the size of the congregation varies, it is currently ranging from 30-35 most of whom are older with only about 6 younger adults.

The Kirov church is currently served by Sergey Danilov, who was trained at the Syktyvkar Bible School. He and his wife Sveta have worked with the church for 6 years. He has worked a second job, but the recession has also hit Russia, and he is working most of the time with his studies, Bible class, sermon preparation, and other needs of the congregation.

Growth and the spread of the Word are, of course, the major goal of the Kirov church. They want to attract more young adults and teenagers to the church so they can grow and be more successful.
