From Ed... I suspect we have all attended a concert of some sort sometime or other. Did you notice that when the musicians were tuning up their instruments before the concert began, each player made their own sounds? There was no harmony, nothing beautiful or pleasant to listen to, nothing that could be called music. It was a cacophony of discordant noise! It wasn't until the director stood before the orchestra and began to conduct, that music replaced bedlam. Harmony required each musician to surrender their own will and submit to the will and music of the conductor.

It is very much like that in the church. When a church is populated with people who have surrendered their will to God and are determined to blend their efforts into harmony with all so that Jesus is glorified, the cause of Christ moves forward. However, it takes only a single instance of disharmony to disrupt! I once sang in the FHC chorus. We were giving a performance at the Estes congregation and I missed a brief practice just before we left. My roommate was supposed to tell me of a pause inserted just before an emphatic note in one of the songs. He forgot (so he said). All went well until that pause. Uninformed, I hit the note with all my tenor voice could give. I was all alone doing so! Everyone else paused. That song was ruined! It only takes one. A hundred soldiers marching with only one out of sync and which do you suppose folks will notice?
