What that requires is all of us encouraging others to come and take a look at what we have to offer: as Andrew told Peter: "Come and see!" I believe when people come and see what a loving and caring church family we have, they will want to come back.

**Growing The Church:** In last week's bulletin I wrote a short article in this section about how to effectively reach outsiders and interest them. It encouraged building relationships and winning others to Christ by an example of Christ-like living. I posted this same article on-line and received feedback. Interestingly, the feedback was negative. It demanded that we must be confrontational with people if we "do it right". The example of Jesus confronting the Pharisees was used as a proof-text. Of course Jesus was confrontational with the Pharisees but we should ask why? Because the Pharisees were operating from the basis of hypocrisy! With others he dealt gently, helping, healing and serving. If Jesus had dealt confrontationally with all, I doubt he would have been followed by admiring multitudes. Of course there came a time when the multitudes were faced with what it meant to be a true disciple, but not until a degree of interest was established. I wonder if those who responded to the on-line post are part of growing or declining congregations.

### Mission Works of the Winchester Church of Christ

**Russia:** The Winchester congregation sponsors a church in the city of Kirov which has a regular membership of 30-35. It has been served by Sergey Danilov since 2003. The church operates from a modern building. They meet regularly with other local congregations to develop strategies for spreading the Word in Russia. Maurice Batchelor and John Kelley are scheduled to leave on a mission trip to Kirov September 17.

**Africa:** The congregation sponsors several works in Africa. The African Christian Schools Foundation includes a Bible Training School, which trains local preachers, and Village Schools provide Christian based education in the local villages. The Zambia missions, is served by David and Lorrie French. They sponsor Mapepe Bible College, Mapepe Center for African missions, and Silent Angels of Orphans. The Bible college graduates have established congregations throughout Zambia.

Joseph Horton and others from the Chattanooga area left Saturday on a mission trip to Ghana, Africa.
