**David Lipscomb:** When Lipscomb was three years old in 1834, his father, Granville, moved the family to Sangamon County, Illinois, (whose county seat, Springfield, would become the state capital in 1837) for the express purpose of freeing the family slaves. During their brief stay, Anne, David's mother, and some of David's siblings died of malaria. Granville moved the remainder of the family back to Franklin County in 1835 and married Jane Breedan in 1837. The Gospel Advocate began in 1855 by Tolbert Fanning and William Lipscomb, David's older brother. It ceased during the Civil War and began anew in 1867. This time David was co-editor with Fanning. The GA was the conservative voice of the Restoration, opposing all innovations like instruments in worship, Sunday Schools and Missionary Societies. Lipscomb was a strong pacifist and also opposed voting. Subsequently, he dropped his opposition to Sunday Schools.

**The World Around Us:** The Walt Disney Co. was ordered to recognize ex-gay employees without discriminating against them and to allow them to express their ex-gay view of homosexuality.—A poll determined religious prejudice in America: 43% are anti-Islamic, 18% anti-Christian, 15% anti Jewish.—After the Jan 12th Haiti earthquake private donations to Haiti relief the following week averaged \$1.64 million *per hour!* Most was given by churches across America.
